Introduction

Through LTAD planning process, the Canadian Cycling Association has been able to take stock of both its assets and challenges, identify opportunities and propose initiatives.

We know that our success depends on partnerships and teamwork across Canada with our different organizations including CCA, National Cycling Centers, Provincial Cycling Associations and clubs.

To be effective in our LTAD implementation we need, at the provincial and at the national level, a clearer picture of our memberships, we need to agree on roles and responsibilities and we need set higher standards.

As the first step of this LTAD initiative, we need to identify the main focus of each affiliated club. This will help us to identify gaps in our development structure as well as identifying success factors.

Your role

Upon renewal of your affiliated clubs, we would expect each PSO to ask their club to identify their main focus as an organization. We've identified 6 different streams as follow:

- High performance development club
- Development club
- Youth Club
- Master and / or Sport Club
- Women club
- Recreational Club

**A club may have multiple focus

Club programming focus

High performance development club

General definition:

A club whose main purpose of its members and its programs is focused towards performance in competitions nationally and internationally. Often these clubs structure are close from a team structure with restricted memberships.

LTAD stages: Train to compete and Learn to win

Athletes: Junior, Senior Espoir (U23), Senior Elite;

Racing focus: UCI races in North America, National races, Provincial races;

Athletes objectives: National Team, Provincial Team

Key Services: Yearly coaching service, provide equipment and financial support to the riders via provincial / national sponsors.

Development club

General definition:

A club whose main purpose of its members and its programs is focused towards athlete's progression and development. Often these clubs are offering the first opportunity to race at the provincial or at the national level.

LTAD stages: Learn to compete and Train to train

Athletes: Cadet, Junior

Racing focus: Provincial races; National Championships, Local races

Athletes objectives: Provincial team

Key Services: Seasonal coaching service, group ride, support at races , organize training camp

Youth Club

General definition:

A club whose main purpose of its members and its programs is focused towards technical / tactical skills development and the fun to ride. Performance is not the club focus. These clubs often have a large memberships.

LTAD stages: Active start, Fundamentals stage and Learn to train

Athletes: Bibittes, Pee Wee, Minime,

Racing focus: Local races, Provincial races

Key Services: Seasonal coaching service, group ride, support at local races

Others: The club is often involve in local race organization

Master and / or Sport Club

General definition:

A club whose members are generally a group of friends whose main purpose of its members and its programs can vary between maintaining the shape and performance of its members at sport / master level races.

LTAD stages: Active for life

Athletes: Master, Sport

Racing focus: Local races, Provincials races,

Key Services: Seasonal coaching service, group ride, support at races

Women Club

General definition:

A club whose main purpose or programs is focused towards women. Often these clubs are offering specific clinics or services for women.

LTAD stages: Can be all stages of the LTAD

Athletes: Can be all categories

Racing focus: Upon the ages and interest of their members

Key Services: Coaching services (often women coach), group ride, support at races

Recreational Club

General definition:

A club whose members are generally a group of friends whose main purpose of its members and its programs is maintaining the shape and achieve personal goals without being constrained by rules of competition.

LTAD stages: Active for life

Members: All ages

Focus: Group ride, organize clinics from members, participate at non-competitive events

Key Services: Provide group ride leader, organize social activities
